Qualifications:

- Be high school senior at either Triton, Western Harnett, Harnett Central, Overhills or Harnett County Early College at the time of application
- Be accepted to an accredited college or university
- Be a full-time student
- Work a part-time job
- Maintain a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0

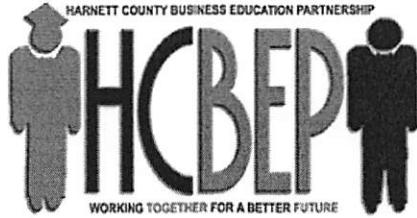
Submission:

 - A current copy of your high school transcript (see your counselor)
 - A letter of recommendation from your current employer
