Criteria for Scholarship:

1. Plan to attend a four year college or university.
2. Maintained a high school academic average of 3.0 or better.
3. Must be a citizen of the United States.
4. Resident of Harnett County for a minimum of 3 years prior to graduation.
5. Personal characteristics which include high moral character, responsibility, involvement in extracurricular activities, physical vigor, achievement, and involvement in community and church activities. Students who have played a varsity sport(s) consistently will be considered first.

- Application/Essay filled out legibly and neatly. **Essay must be handwritten.**
- Current Transcript (to be attached by your guidance counselor)
