



## 2020-2021 TRANSITION TO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

- Five-day instruction for grades K-5 begins on Monday, October 26.
- Five-day instruction for grades 6-12 will begin on a future date once authorized by the Governor via Executive Order.
- Pre-Kindergarten programs are already operating on a five-day schedule.
- If families prefer, students may continue with five days of remote instruction.
- Families may change the instructional setting for their student(s) on Monday, October 26 if the school is notified by October 16.
- Social distancing within classrooms will be attempted but cannot be guaranteed in schools on a 5-day instructional schedule.
- During holidays and teacher workdays, there will be no remote or in-person instruction.
- Per state law, remote learning is for all students on remote days, identified as “SRL” on the 2020-2021 Harnett County Schools calendar.

### **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23**

Final day of A/B schedule for K-5 students.

### **MONDAY, OCTOBER 26**

Five-day daily in-person instruction (Plan A) begins for students in grades K-5.

### **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3**

Teacher Workday for all students.

### **WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4**

Remote learning day for students in grades 6-12.

### **WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 11**

Veteran’s Day Holiday for all students and staff.

### **MONDAY, NOVEMBER 23**

“A” day for in-person instruction in grades 6-12.

### **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24**

“B” day for in-person instruction in grades 6-12.

### **WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 25**

Early release day for students in grades K-5.

Remote learning day with early release for students in grades 6-12.

### **THURSDAY NOVEMBER 26 & FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 27**

Thanksgiving Holiday for all students and staff.
